NEW COLLABORATION SIGNING: WESTGATE COLLEGE (PRIVATE) LIMITED, SRI LANKA

The Covid-19 pandemic has been affecting many countries as well as many organisations globally since the Corona Virus was first found at the end of 2019. Since then, front liners who work in medical lines were extremely demanded by many countries. Due to this demand, Asia Metropolitan University (AMU) has successfully secured a new collaboration with Westgate College (Private) Limited (WGC), an international institution in Sri Lanka on expanding AMU market to the international arena for the nursing programme.

The Memorandum of Agreement was officially signed and established on 15 March 2021 after a series of discussion and negotiation we done since December 2020.

WGC is an institution that provides facilities and programmes at their study centre for students of undergraduate and postgraduate studies with foreign universities recognised by the University Grant Commission (UGC) in Sri Lanka, and provide opportunities into national and international employment. The collaboration programme which is going to be conducted in WGC is also approved by the Ministry of Health and Indigenous Medical Services of Sri Lanka.

With this agreement, WGC will be conducting a One-Year Top-Up Degree for Bachelor of Nursing (Hons) Programme owned by AMU at their study centre for registered nurses in Sri Lanka who wish to pursue their academic qualification in nursing. The programme is expected to commence in April 2021.

This collaboration is hoped to provide more avenues and opportunities for the university to expand further into international markets and it may also help to create more platforms for international students' recruitment to AMU.



OTHER NEW COLLABORATIONS

Besides the new collaboration with an institution in Sri Lanka, AMU has also secured many other understandings and agreements within Malaysia as well as with Singapore and China institutes and organisations. Among others, the purpose of the partnerships will be beneficial for student internship, job employment, franchising programmes, education materials and software, academics research & facilities as well as additional payment platform for AMU's clients. With these new collaborations, it is hoped that AMU will move forward towards producing more quality graduates to fulfill the global industry and professional requirements.
